We have a simple, functional plan - to be CO2 neutral by 2030. It's vital to do everything we can to keep global warming below the 1.5C tipping point, as established in the Paris Agreement in 2015.

A big part of becoming CO2 neutral is our target to increase Petit Crabe's recycled material use from its current 70% up to a full 100%.

Using recycled materials is one way to cut emissions, reduce virgin crude oil use, and save on resources. Petit Crabe also designs with longevity in mind, creating classic garments that can be passed down from one adventurous kid to another.
